

Fellowship Bible Study: The Board of Control is continuing a study of scripture’s doctrine of fellowship. The WELS Conference of Presidents provided and encouraged all area Lutheran high schools to review this important and practical application of Biblical principles.

2015-16 Long Range Goals: This year there are 12 goals, ranging from strengthening connections with LHS alumni to digital textbooks, which various committees and groups will be addressing.

1. Contract with fundraising professional to assess extent of financial support for Master Plan building initiatives
2. Digital video class produces fall and spring videos promoting Luther High School within association congregations and schools

3. Secure appropriate permits for new construction and renovations
4. Construct 40' X 80' athletic storage facility
5. Renovate old locker rooms to provide more appealing and functional facilities for teams
6. Re-activate the Luther High School Alumni Association
7. Promote Luther High School curriculum in publications
8. Re-evaluate format and effectiveness of current publications and financial appeals
9. Implement digital textbooks
10. Develop formal faculty continuing education policy
11. Consider relocating the Applied Home Maintenance class to another location to provide more space and a safer learning environment
12. Develop job description and funding plan to enable hiring of mission advancement personnel

Committee Reports

- **Master Plan Capital Campaign Committee:** Interviews, surveys, meetings and analysis identifies the activities of the current campus improvement awareness and readiness study. A summary report will be given **7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27**. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend this meeting.
- **Master Plan Building Committee:** Construction of the athletic storage building will begin in the next few weeks. This building is a long awaited and much needed campus addition.
- **School Choice Wisconsin Ad Hoc Committee (Voucher Program):** Terry Brown of School Choice Wisconsin met with several of the members of the ad hoc committee directed to study this program. While helpful insights were shared, it was clear that much more information will be forthcoming. The committee will continue their study and review of this program during the current school year.
- **Mission Advancement Officer:** An ad hoc committee is being formed to study this opportunity.
