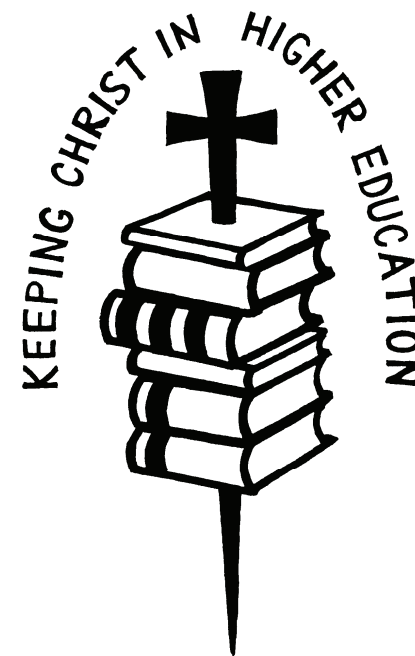
Career counseling, course selection, and personal/spiritual counseling are offered. Referrals to home pastors and WI Lutheran Christian Counseling are made as necessary.
