SEMESTER EXAMS GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All tests will be given in the Commons
2. The library / media center will be closed during test days.
3. No student will be dismissed before the ending time listed on the schedule.
4. Students will sit in assigned seats according to the posted seating chart.
5. Students may not bring electronic devices, unless directed to do so by an instructor.
6. Students' attire must be in compliance with the dress code.
7. Students need not come to school if they have no tests, but if they are here, they must be studying in the testing room. Students may not loiter in the building or outside on campus.
8. Students who come for a late test or leave after an early test are expected to be in chapel.
9. Students with test conflicts should make arrangements with their teacher. Conflicts are when two tests are scheduled at the same time.
10. As long as things are kept neat, students may have a snack and / or beverage at their desks.
11. Students may keep study materials under their desks. They may not go to their lockers to get materials when they have finished writing a test.
12. Bus departure times during semester exams will be 12:00 PM, except for the last day of exams when the bus departure time will be 11:00 AM. The afternoon Onalaska bus will pick up only if requested.
13. Students who have part-time jobs need to make sure their work schedule does not conflict with their scheduled exam times.

14. These exams count a substantial part of the semester grade.
15. If weather conditions cause school to be closed on a scheduled exam day that day's exam schedule will be followed the next scheduled exam day.
Should weather conditions cause school to be closed on Monday, December 18th both exams scheduled will be administered Tuesday, December 19th
Should weather conditions cause school to be closed the last day of semester exams, those exams will be administered after the Christmas break.
