Daily Bus Transportation Guidelines: 2020-2021

Luther High School and GO Riteway are committed to the health and safety of our students and staff. To this end, we have implemented the following recommended BEST practices to help protect our passengers and professional drivers:

Parent Responsibility

- Students must be pre-registered to ride the bus.
- Students must self-screen for COVID symptoms daily before boarding the bus. (see prescreening checklist)
- Only one student per seat unless members of the same family are present. Exceptions must be filed in advance.

For Students - On the Bus

- All students will be required to wear a face covering (as long as the state mask mandate is in place).
- As students enter the bus, they will be asked to fill from the back to the front.
- As students exit the bus, they will be asked to leave from front to back.
- Students should remain seated and facing the front for the duration of the trip.
- No food or beverages will be allowed.
- Passengers will not be able to use the seat directly behind the driver.

Bus Cleaning / Driver – Student Awareness

- Vehicles will be sanitized daily with all high touch surface areas wiped down.
- 8 ½" x 11" COVID safety precaution poster will be displayed in each bus.
- All drivers are required to wear face masks when passengers are on the bus.
- Drivers are reporting body temperature and answering screening questions prior to shift to ensure those are experiencing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 remain at home and do not report for duty.
- Drivers are trained and furnished with information about COVID-19
 - How it spreads and the exposure risks.
 - Proper hand sanitizing/hand washing practices and other safety precautions.

COVID-19 Symptom Checklist

Pre-screening Questions

Parent Pre-Screening (at home)

Parents/Guardians are to screen child(ren) at home (temperature, signs/symptoms)

- If your child can answer YES to any of these questions, do not send them to school:
 - Do you have a fever? 100.4° F or higher
 - Do you have a cough?
 - Do you have a sore throat?
 - Do you have shortness of breath?
 - Have you had close contact or had cared for someone with COVID-19?
- If a fever is suspected, a reading should be taken. If a temperature of 100.4° F or higher is found, student should remain at home.
