 - General English (2 semesters) – Senior course w/pre-requisite of Dept Recommendation
 - Mechatronics (1 semester) – 9-12 w/pre-requisite of Alg I or Alg I-P2

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- ✓ Notes/Reminders:
 - All yearlong courses were split into semester courses with the first semester course ending with “A” and the second semester course ending with “B”
 - Spanish IV – Independent Study
 - ✓ This course is primarily for transfer students and requires special circumstances to enroll
 - Dual Credit Bethany College courses & AGVA courses must be
 - ✓ registered by the student with either Bethany or AGVA
 - ✓ paid for separately by the student (not included with LHS tuition)
 - ✓ must be reported to the Registrar’s office to receive credit
 - Some Practical Arts courses (e.g. Woods 1, Woods 2, etc.) may not be available for Freshmen & Sophomores to pick during the Skyward course selection process because these courses tend to be very heavy with Jrs/Srs and often times they are filled. The Freshmen & Sophomores can do a Drop/Add form once the schedules are distributed. In a typical year there are only a few slots open affecting less than 5 student schedules.
