



How Luther High School's Tuition Is Affordable for You

10 Sources of Tuition Assistance

1. **The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)** - For Wisconsin Residents only. This program is based on income. If you qualify your whole tuition will be covered by WPCP. Filing usually opens on February 1. For more details please go to: dpi.wi.gov/choice
2. **SCRIP Program** - Gift cards and certificates to a wide variety of businesses are available for purchase through the school office. Using Scrip for purchases you normally would make can earn income to be credited to a current Luther High student. Details about the Scrip program are available in the school office.
3. **Tuition Assistance Application from Luther High School**
FACTS Tuition Assistance opens for following year on November 1. The filing deadline is February 15th.
4. **Tuition Assistance from home congregation** - Ask your pastor if your congregation has such a program and who to contact.
5. **Good Steward Volunteer Program** - Contact Pastor Sachs for details
6. **Family Support** - Perhaps a grandparent or sponsor would be able to provide financial assistance with tuition
7. **Student Tuition Endowment Fund (STEF)** –Interest from this permanent fund can provide each Luther High student a tuition grant. ***For the 2022-2023 school year each student is eligible to receive \$365.***
8. **Grant from Luther High School** - ***For the 2022-2023 school year each student is eligible to receive \$325***
9. **Grant from Friends of Luther** - ***For the 2022-2023 school year each student is eligible to receive \$100***
10. **Grant from Good Steward Store** - ***For the 2022-2023 school year each student is eligible to receive \$300***
